

## **RETURNING AND TEMPORARY SWIMMERS**

Returning and/or Temporary Swimmers are defined as:

- a) Swimmers who attend fulltime an accredited university and who are returning to join the swim club for the latter portion of the season generally after their university season has ended.
- b) Other Swimmers who wish to join the swim club on a temporary basis
  - a) All such swimmers must adhere to the following: Abide by all club policies including the code of conduct, team wear, travel and meet sign out processes. For any meet or training camp designated as a Team Meet or Team Training Camp the athletes will travel (where practicable) and must room with the team. Travel exceptions require the approval of the Head Coach.
  - b) Train and compete under the sole direction of an ESWIM coach. The athlete will be available for events (usually relays) determined by the ESWIM coaches that help the Program meet its objectives. Also, the athlete upon return and at meets is expected to train with the team, partaking in the training sessions designed by the ESWIM coaches and undertaken by the remainder of the club; and,
  - c) Undertake to be a positive influence by supporting the team dynamic and cohesiveness of the team

## **UNIVERSITY SWIMMERS**

### **UNIVERSITY WINTER POLICY Sept 1st – May 31st**

This program will be applied during the academic university year until the end of May generally Sept. 1 – May 31. It is for swimmers whose application for membership with The Etobicoke Swim Club as a competitive swimmer has been accepted and the swimmer is currently attending an accredited university on a full time basis (full time as defined by that institution).

Swimmer or swimmer parent will be responsible for the following Volunteer Commitment: 7.5 deck hours & 90 points for each month of the season that the swimmer is a member of the Etobicoke Swim Club.

Swimmer will be required to pay all fees as per the fee schedule of a competitive swimmer prorated based on the time the swimmer is a member of the Etobicoke Swim Club. Swimmer will also be entitled to a further discount of Membership Fees, Swim Fees and Minimum Fundraising Commitment based on years of membership prior to attending university. This applies to all swimmers: (fee schedule based upon the swimmer's group fees and the time they attend the period up to May 31<sup>st</sup>.)

Members for:

4 or more years = 100 % discount 3 years = 75% discount  
2 years = 50% discount 1 year = 25% discount

All qualified swimmers will also be responsible for the following costs:

**Registration fee: \$250 see criteria above**

**Racing account deposit: by group**

**All Travel costs**

## **UNIVERSITY SUMMER POLICY**

This policy applies to university swimmers returning at the completion of the academic year. Generally June 1–Aug 31 but may vary due to differences in the finish dates for the American spring academic semester.

### **National Standard Swimmers**

Registration fees: Waived  
Racing Account: \$550 deposit required  
Swim/membership/fundraising fees: Waived  
Travel: Swimmer to cover all costs

### **Non-National Standard Swimmers**

Registration fees: \$150 paid by Swimmer  
Racing Account: \$550 deposit required  
Swim/membership/fundraising fees: Waived  
Travel: Swimmer to cover all costs  
\* Swimmer's account from prior years must be in good standing including all points and on deck hour commitments.

### **Other Swimmers**

Other swimmers are swimmers whose application for membership with The Etobicoke Swim Club as a competitive swimmer has been accepted for a limited period however the swimmer is not necessarily expected to become a regular member.

Swimmer or swimmer parent will be responsible for the following Volunteer Commitment: 7.5 deck hours and 90 points for each month of the season that the swimmer is a member of The Etobicoke Swim Club.

Swimmer will be required to pay all fees as per the fee schedule of a competitive swimmer prorated based on the time the swimmer is a member of The Etobicoke Swim Club.

## **NATIONAL TRAINING CENTRE/ACADEMY SWIMMERS**

As a rule, swimmers who train full time throughout the year in another Canadian Program would be ineligible for membership.

This classification of member is for swimmers who train full time throughout the year with either a National Training Centre or Academy and whose application for membership with The Etobicoke Swim Club as a competitive swimmer has been accepted.

A meeting with the swimmer and the swimmer's Centre/Academy Coach must be held with the ESWIM Head Coach prior to the swimmer's membership application for membership being considered.

The swimmer must also agree to and meet the following requirements:

a) Abide by all club policies including the code of conduct, teamwear, travel and meet sign out processes. For any meet or training camp designated as a Team Meet or Team Training Camp the athletes will travel and must room with the team. Travel exceptions must be at the approval of the Head Coach.

b) Compete under the direction of an ESWIM coach. The athlete will be available for events (usually relays) determined by the ESWIM coaches that help the Program meet its objectives.

c) Undertake to be a positive influence by supporting the team dynamic and cohesiveness of the team.

The following financial and volunteer commitment will apply:

**Registration fees: Waived**

**Racing Account Deposit: Will be determined and due upon application**

**Swim/membership/fundraising fees: Waived**

**Points & Hours commitment: Waived**

**Travel: Swimmer to cover all costs**
